

## **Press release**

MYANMAR'S stance on the Taiwan question amid the current tensions is as follows:-

- (a) Myanmar was the earliest country to recognize the People's Republic of China following its establishment and has consistently upheld the One-China policy. This position has been reaffirmed during meetings between the leaders of the two countries. Moreover, Myanmar supports China's vision of achieving peaceful reconciliation with Taiwan.
- (b) As two countries that have agreed to and adhere to the Five Principles of Peaceful Coexistence, Myanmar and China mutually respect each other's territorial integrity and sovereignty and emphasize efforts to uphold these principles.
- (c) Myanmar recognizes that the Taiwan question is an internal affair of China, in line with the principle that the two countries respect each other's internal affairs, and reaffirms that Taiwan is an inseparable part of China. As secessionist activities may give rise to conflict, it is necessary to prevent and refrain from encouraging such activities.
- (d) It was stated that Myanmar has pledged to always stand with China as a good neighbour, a strategic partner, and a co-founder of a kinship community, through thick and thin.
